'Overcoming My Fear of Failure'

Scripture reference: Matthew 25:24-27

²⁴ He also who had received the one talent came forward, saying, 'Master, I knew you to be a hard man, reaping where you did not sow, and gathering where you scattered no seed, ²⁵ so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground. Here, you have what is yours.' ²⁶ But his master answered him, 'You wicked and slothful servant! You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed? ²⁷ Then you ought to have invested my money with the bankers, and at my coming I should have received what was my own with interest.

Overcoming my fear:

1. RETHINK your <u>UNDERSTANDING</u> of failure.

It does not <u>DISCRIMINATE</u> Romans 3:23; James 3:2
 It does not <u>DESTROY</u> Proverbs 24:16a; Romans 8:28
 It does not <u>DEFINE</u> Psalm 139:14; John 1:12

2. <u>REFOCUS</u> your <u>PERSPECTIVE</u> on failing.

- It's more about the <u>MASTER</u> than <u>ME</u>.

 "so I was afraid, and I went and hid your talent in the ground."

 Matthew 25:25
- The <u>PERSON</u> of Jesus is bigger than the <u>PROBLEM</u> of fear.

 "You knew that I reap where I have not sown and gather where I scattered no seed?" Matthew 25:26
- The <u>REWARD</u> outweighs the <u>RISK</u>.
 "Well done, good and faithful servant. You have been faithful over a little; I will set you over much. Enter into the joy of your master.'
